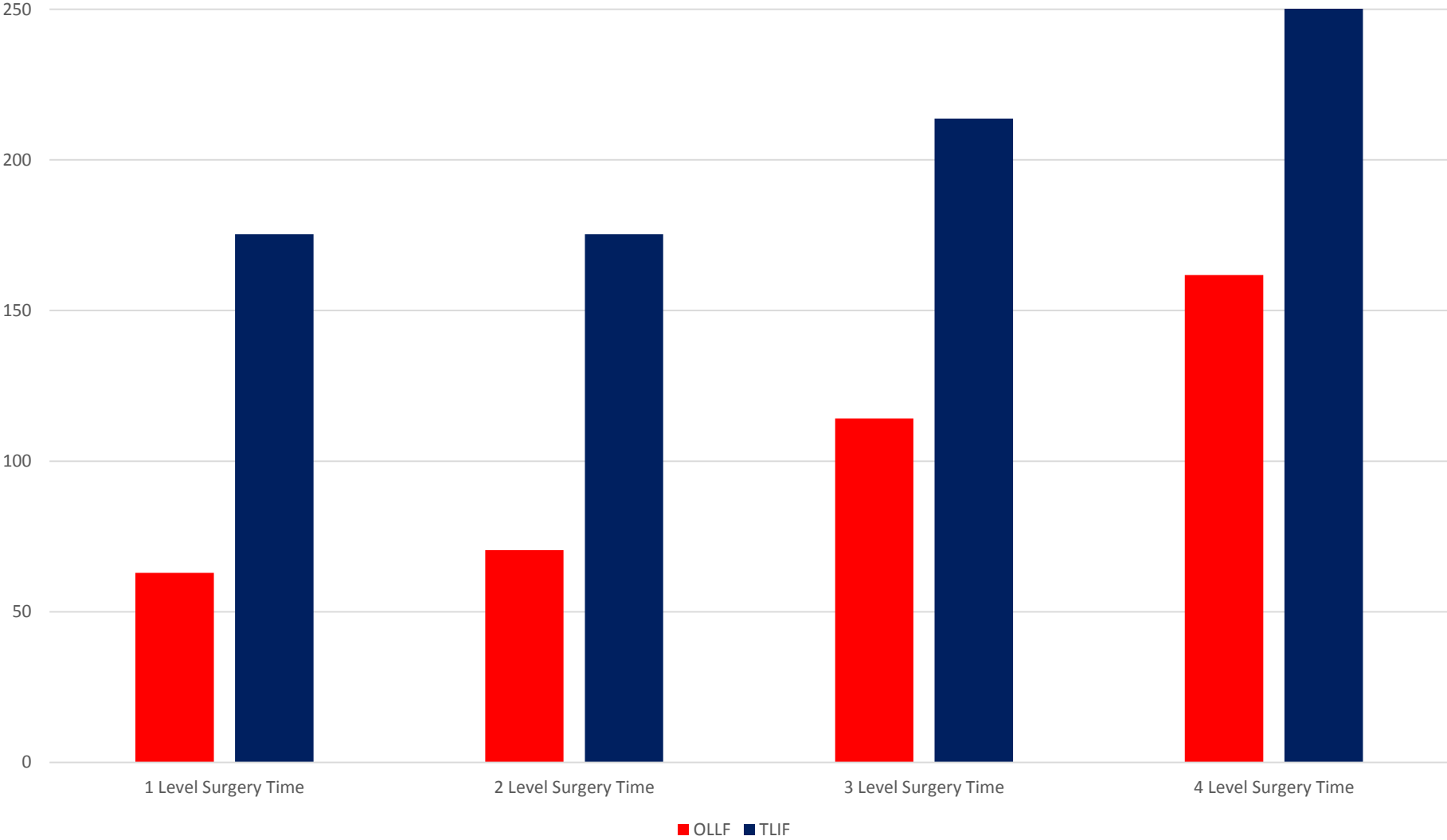
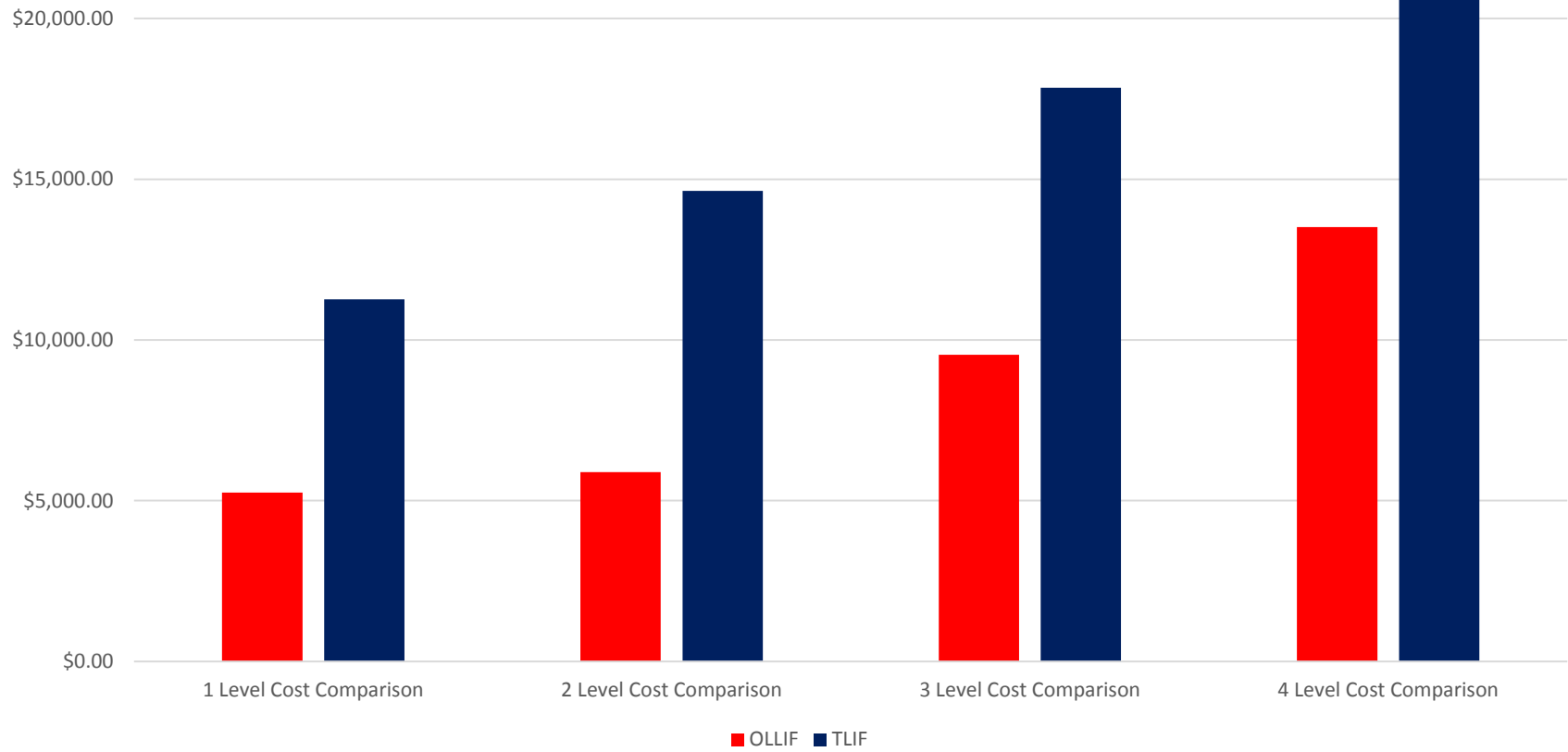

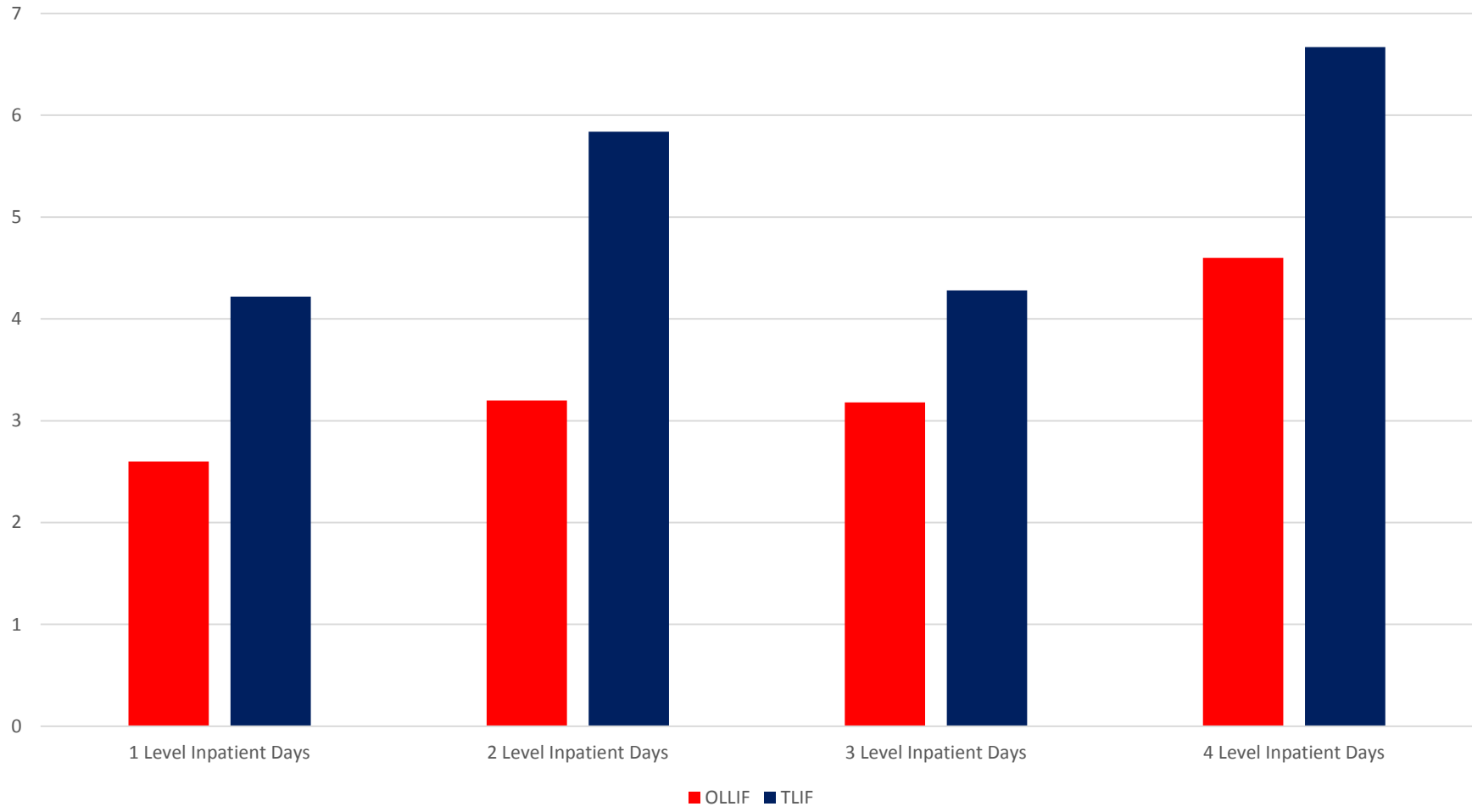
Surgery Time Cost Comparison



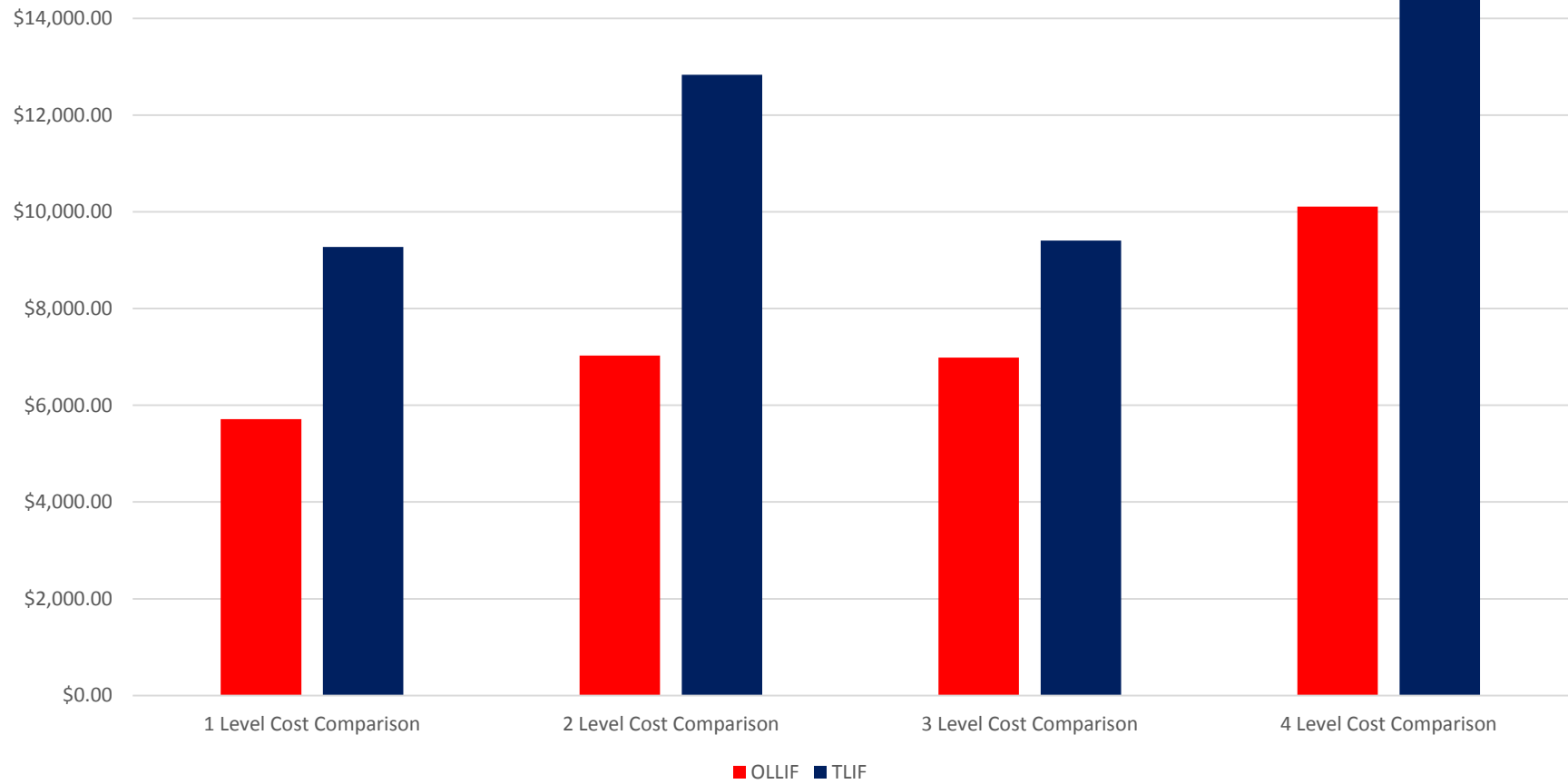

Inpatient Days

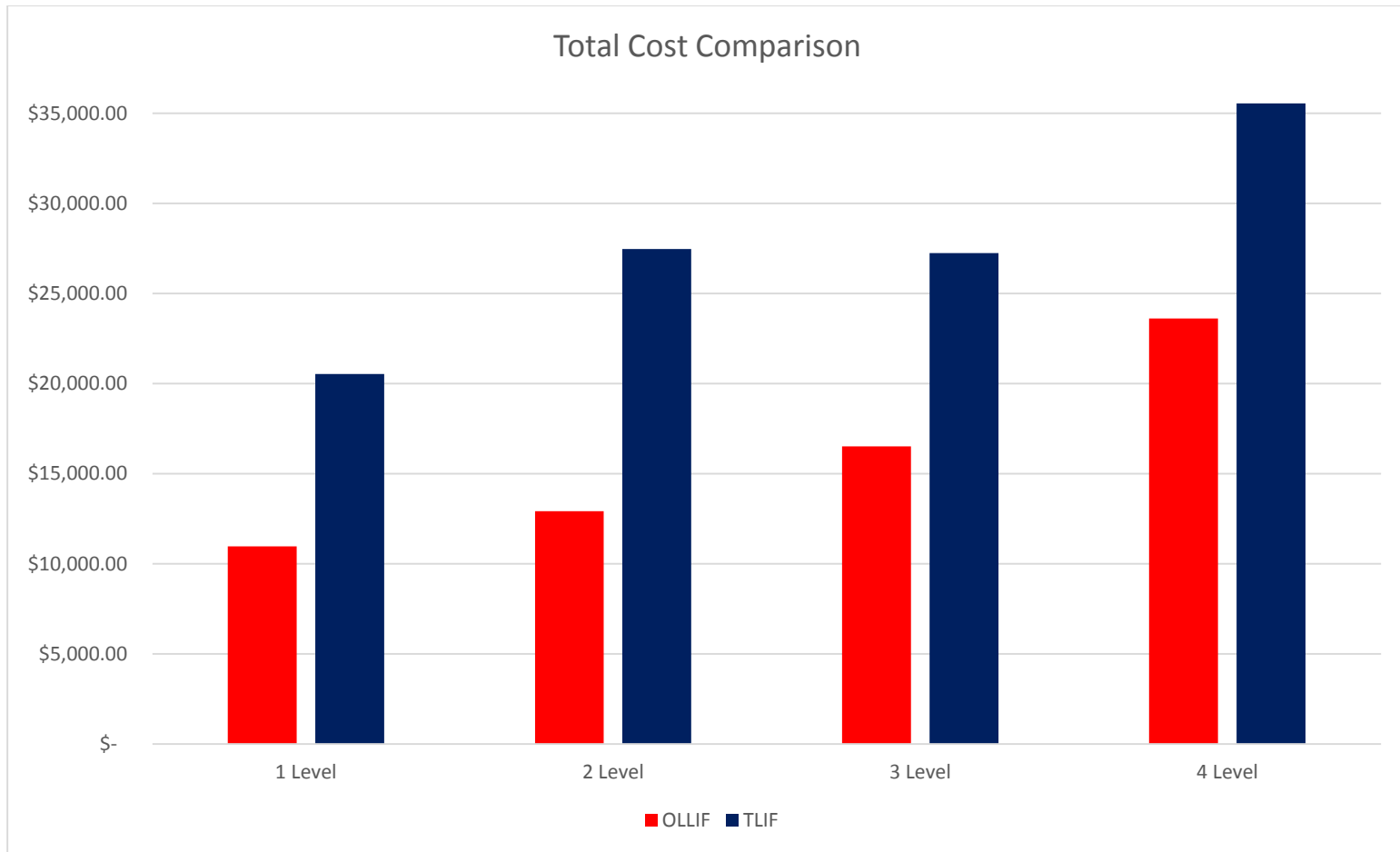


Inpatient Days Cost Comparison

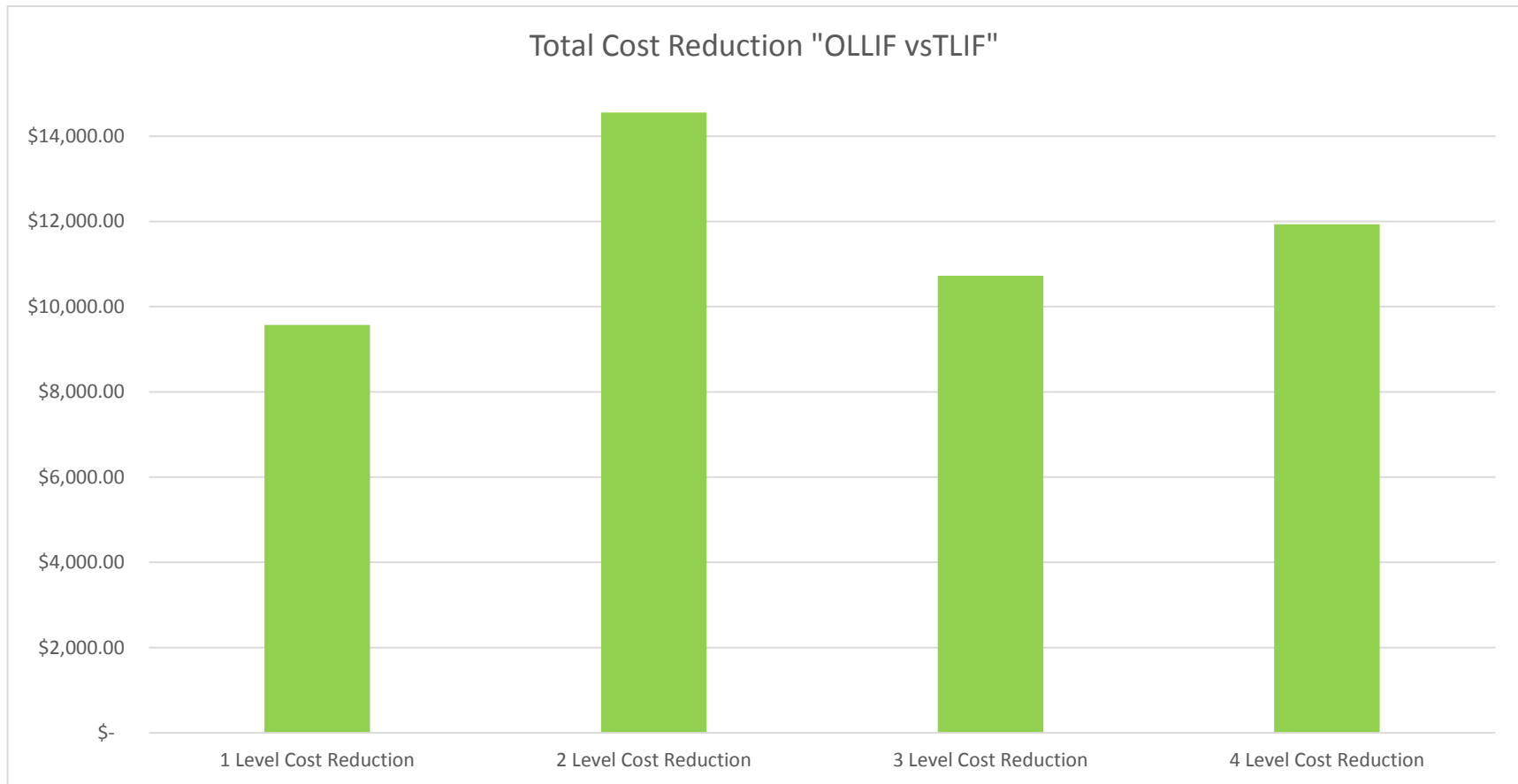
